"Abifillage: My Society and I," invites you into a vibrant world where figurativism meets expressionism and traditional visual codes are reimagined, in celebration of the beauty of African art and identity. Prosper Aluu, with his masterful strokes and unique vision, offers a profound exploration of African culture, history, and contemporary existence through his compelling artworks.

Drawing inspiration from his upbringing immersed in comics and character illustrations, Aluu employs the art form of elongation and exaggeration through his stylized figures, adorning them with iconic afro hairstyles and golden crowns to channel the affirmations of dignity and nobility whilst challenging narratives surrounding African representation. Central to Aluu's artistic practice is his innovative style "Abfillage", a fusion of the abstract, figurative and collage techniques. Through this process, Aluu not only immortalizes contemporary stories and narratives but also infuses them with vibrant colors, transforming tragic social stories into captivating moments of resilience.

As we immerse ourselves in this exhibition, Prosper Aluu beckons us to join him on a journey of discovery, reflection, and celebration—a journey that resonates with the vibrant spirit of Africa and the enduring power of artistic expression.

PROSPER ALUU (b. 1999)

Born and raised in Nigeria, West Africa, Prosper Aluu makes figurative and expressive paintings. Prosper grew up drawing comics and characters which enabled him to understand the human figure and expressions properly, after which he became a full-time studio artist in 2017. Prosper studied at the Federal University of Technology Owerri, where he learnt Building technology with an architectural background on designing. He also acquired expertise in graphic design, illustration, 3D modelling, video editing and animation. In 2018, he had his first official art exhibition where he won the Peace Poster award for his painting on Peace at the ANBUKRAFT. He has participated in several exhibitions and competitions since then. In 2020, he was signed as a brand ambassador to TECNO mobile Nigeria for one year. His stylized figures show the use of the artistic devices of elongation and exaggeration and his unique style of painting the iconic afro hairstyle. These are his ways of celebrating and negotiating African identity. Prosper plays with the size, forms and presentation of the head of the figures in his paintings as a visual pun to challenge what he considers a one-sided narrative about the size of the head in traditional African art. By using Nigerian newspapers in his works, he tells stories of past by preserving stories of the present. While he focuses on black identity, with this he believes that to preserve culture, he must continue to create it. "Abfillage" (A portmanteau of Abstract, Figurative and collage) s his unique process and techniques for producing his works and his style of painting rich afro hairstyles with golden crowns on the heads of his figures are meant to ennoble and dignify the subject. His works has appeared in countries like, South Africa, United Kingdom, United States, Canada, Japan etc. Nigeria, b. 1999.


















