ACTIVITIES

- Organizes all the technical and logistical means necessary for the production and operation of shows, events and demonstrations, within the framework of the artistic and cultural projects of the structure
- Supervise the delivery and installation of logistics and signage at the location of a show or filming
- allocated budgets and technical expenses relating to shows, events
- Control the progress of a shoot or a performance
- Solve production anomalies and malfunctions
- Ensures good reception and working conditions for the artistic and technical teams;
- Verifies the conditions of reception, comfort and accessibility for the public;
- Controls the upkeep and maintenance of stage equipment and event spaces;
- Ensures a watch on the technological evolution of the equipment and the scenic material
